## DISPOSE OF CONTACT LENSES PROPERLY!

- 45 million people in the U.S. wear contact lenses
- 15-20% of contact wearers flush lenses down the sink or toilet
- An estimated 6-10 metric tons of plastic lenses end up in wastewater in the U.S. each year
- In wastewater treatment, lenses likely breakdown to form microplastics
- Microplastics pose risk to aquatic organisms, marine animals, and entire food supply
